When taking a pedicab, always be respectful when negotiating, wait in commonly used, safe locations, and clearly clarify the fee and destination to prevent misunderstandings.

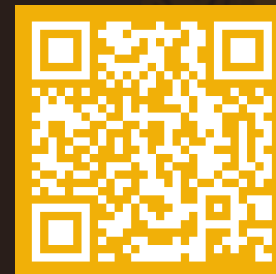
